Dennis Neil Dillon was born in Wheatland, Wyoming in 1926, the youngest of six children, grew to age ten on a small farm, then moved with his family to Corvallis, Oregon. Upon graduation from high school where he played football and competed in track, he joined the U.S. Navy in 1944. The Navy first sent him to Willamette University in Salem, Oregon, and then to the University of Washington, Seattle. Dennis was commissioned as Ensign in June 1946 and later received a degree in Naval Science. While at the University, he and Shirley Crial met at a dance and married in 1948. His first sea duty was aboard the destroyer, Charles P. Cecil, an escort of the carrier, Boxer. In late 1946, he was transferred to a patrol craft escort in Adak, Alaska. Discharged from the Navy in May 1947, the G. I. Bill took him to Oregon State College to seek a degree in Civil Engineering. Following graduation in 1949, he was employed by Peter Kewit Sons' Co., a privately owned construction company. The Dillon's only child, son, Robert was born in1959 while they were living in Billings, Montana. Dennis spent his

career in the construction business which took the family from Oregon to Washington to Montana to Kansas to Nebraska and finally to Houston, Texas. For a period of time, he worked as an arbitrator of construction controversies. His last case was in 2002. He and Shirley have traveled the world. He has had a pilot's license, used to ride motorcycles, enjoyed his sailboat and played many rounds of golf, even at St. Andrews, Scotland. Longtime Baptists, Dennis and Shirley recently joined Nassau Bay Baptist Church after a 20-year membership in the Second Baptist Church, Houston. First becoming a Rotarian in Nebraska 1975, Dennis has been a member of the Wichita Kansas Downtown Rotary Club and Space Center Rotary Club where he was inducted in 1987. He has been a member of Gideons International since 1969 and has held every camp office and committee at least once.
