#### A YEAR TO REMEMBER....

In 1910, the National Association of Rotary Clubs formed and held its first Convention in Chicago, Illinois. Paul P. Harris became Rotary's first president and Chesley R. Perry was elected as the first secretary. The Objects of Rotary were formulated at this milestone Convention. That year, there were 16 clubs with an estimated membership of 1,500. And the first Rotary club outside the United States was formed in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada (admitted to Rotary International in 1911-12).

DID YOU KNOW?.....The Rotary Foundation will support 1250 Rotary Scholars in the 1982-83 year, (618 men and 632 women) studying in 65 different countries. This program, together with all other Foundation grants, will amount to an expenditure this year of \$18.6 million.
