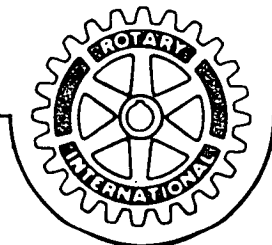

--with our District 589 Governor making the presentation to him--

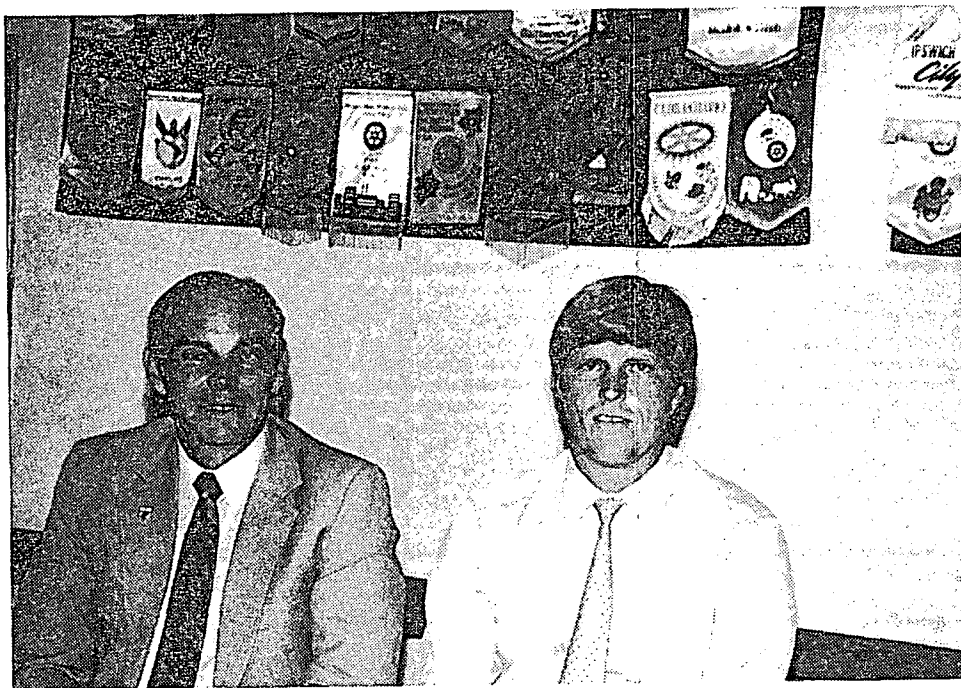
