MEETING OF SEP. 28: After Bill Rittenhouse roused us in song in a bid to outdo Ray Oraham's thunder of the week before, Vic Maria introduced our speaker, Ambassador Andrew Killgore. Killgore spoke on the basis of his career of foreign service in Middle East geopolitics. Some of his points:

- ☐ The Balfour Declaration that created the State of Israel ignored the existence of Palestinian Arabs—the result is still with us today.
  - 1 It is dangerous for any one power to dominate the Persian Gulf.
- ☐ The Arabs call it the Arab Gulf— the Iranians call it the Persian Gulf— the locals call it "the Gulf."
  - ☐ The Iran-Iraq war takes pressure off Israeli-Arab conflicts.
- Foreign Service officers were not allowed to talk with the opposition to the Shah. That, together with a blank check to purchase (Cont'd. on P.2)






