


- □ Serve as a Greeter. (80% of the present "class" have done this.)

- Attend the monthly social event held on the 2nd Wednesday of each month. (PUT THE DECEMBER SOCIAL ON YOUR CALENDAR FOR 5:15 PM AT SUN REALTY ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 9TH. 


