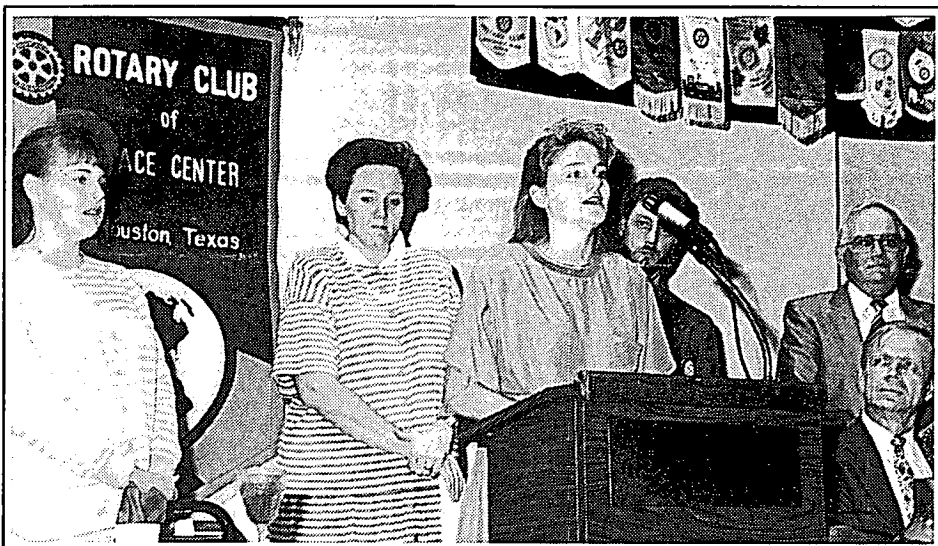

***Dave barely missed making a hole-in-one (and a \$10,000 prize) and he did not cry about it.

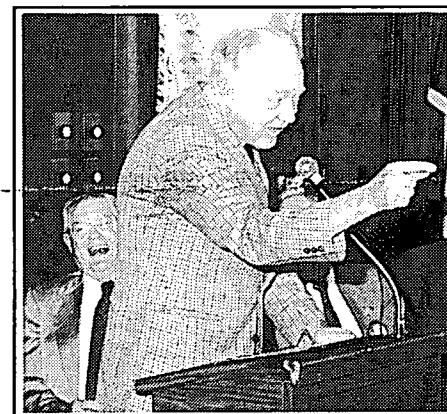
****Carlos was actually very well dressed, but the committee wanted to give him some award for his contributions to the club and to the good time all of the golfers had that day.
