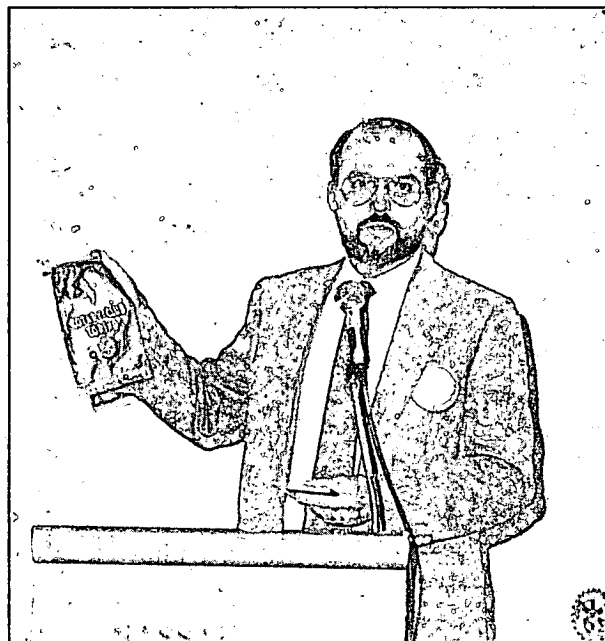

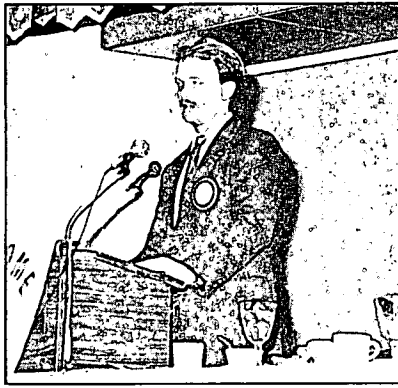

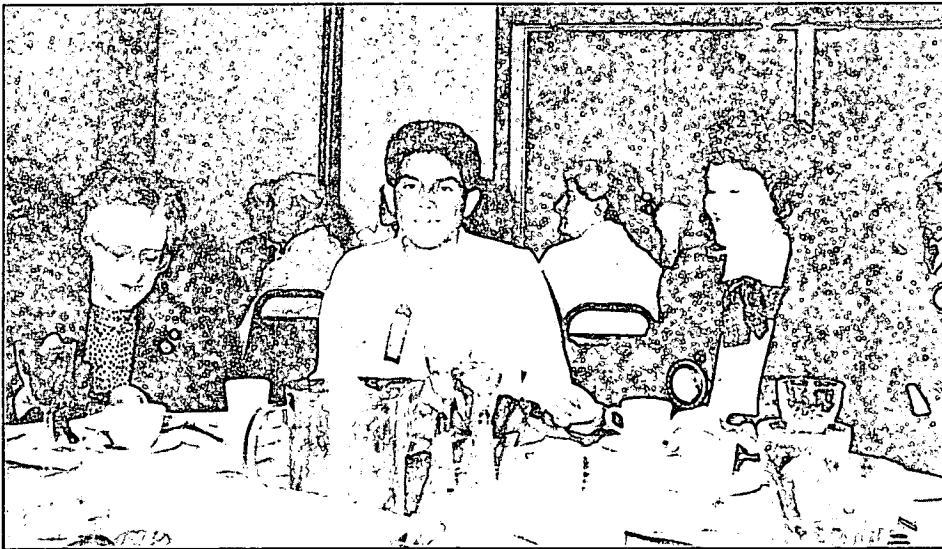
*Red Badge member Mike Hernandez shows off a flag he found in the parking lot. (But seriously, folks, he did bring it back from his visit to the Torino club.)*

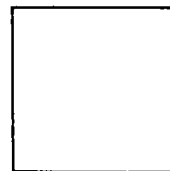
