

ROTARY IN ACTION

It Takes Alot of Pluck.

The tale that follows is not for the faint hearted. It's for us swarthy Rotarians who like a good cause and who don't mind a little blood.

In mid-December Pete Zamora was contacted by Mike Peavey and Ginger Godshall owners and operators of the Dream Acres ranch in League City. Pete contacted Vic Maria who said that Dream Acres would like to donate 50 ducks to the hungry.

Vic then got on the phone to John Watson to confirm that this would be a worthwhile Rotary project. With John's blessing, Vic contacted Maggie Cochran at Interfaith Caring Ministries to see if she could distribute the ducks to

people who could really use them.

With Maggie's assurance, Vic made it all happen. First, he got a truck donated for the morning by Max Yarbrough. Then he lined up volunteers (duck pluckers, if you will) to help dress out the ducks. 50 dead ducks were then hauled over to the Bay Area Meat Market. David Steinke, the meat market manager, donated his facilities for the Rotarians to use. So the Duck Plucking Brigade went into action. They cut, and cleaned, and plucked for 4 hours until all the ducks were cleaned. Dave Steinke's staff wrapped and froze the ducks, so that Maggie could pick them

up and distribute them in time for Christmas.

Vic Maria reported that everyone he called was willing to help and supportive of the unique project. He said that a great big duck hug is in order for those that helped and for those who tried but couldn't due to logistics.

John Watson also extended his hand in thanks, saying "this was a project that showed the true spirit of Rotary - people were resourceful and they communicated well to bring good to those who needed it." Good job to all involved-this took alot of pluck.



Congrats to those elected and thanks to those who volunteered to serve.


Thanks Eddie Tarin


