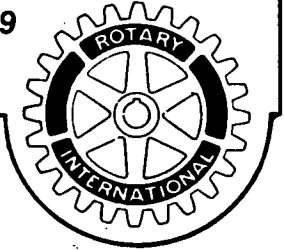

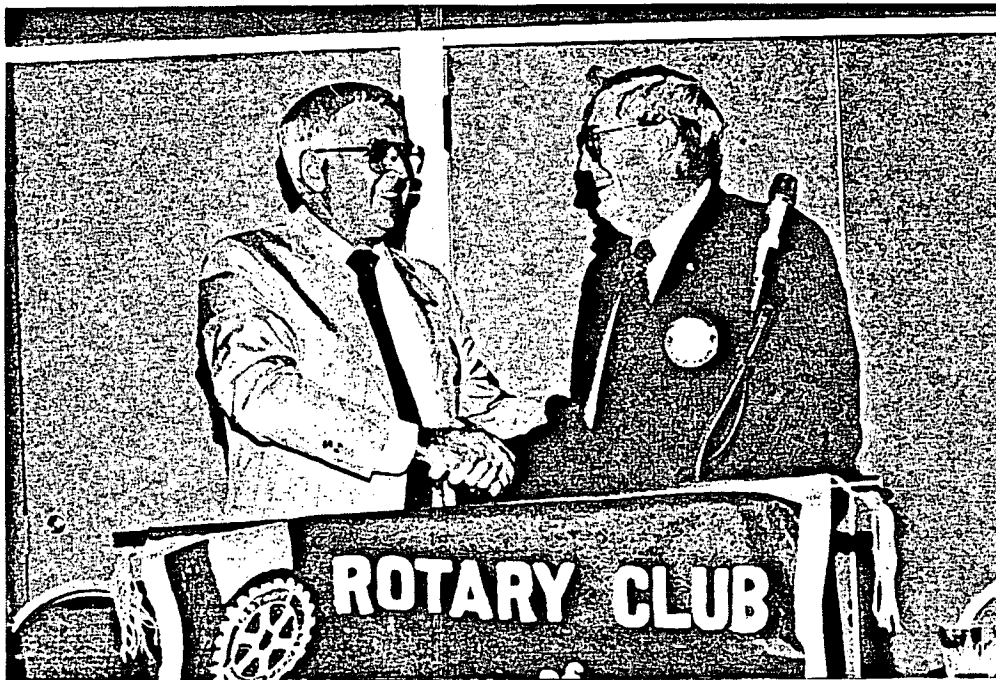

Project Free Enterprise has Christmas

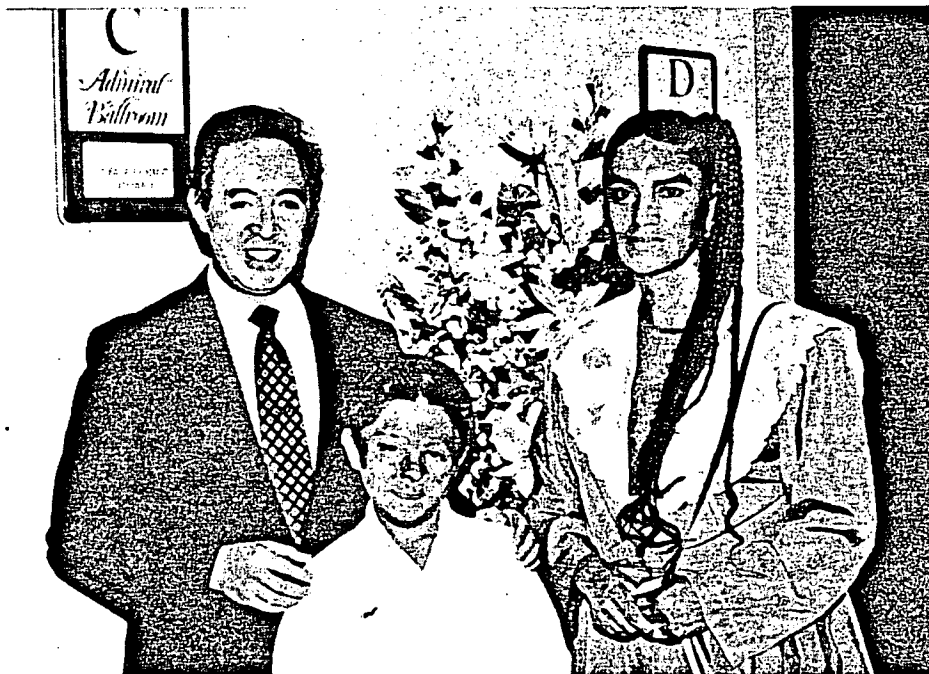
