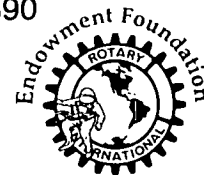

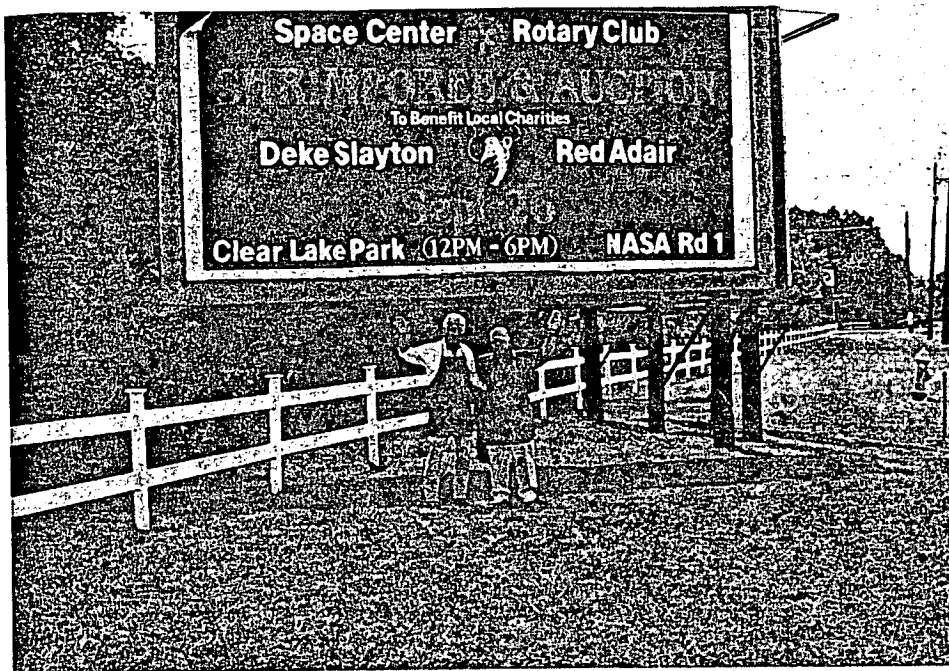
Ron Blilie introduced our newest Rotarian, Doug Strahm, an engineering graduate of the University of South Florida, currently working with Honeywell Space Engineering.

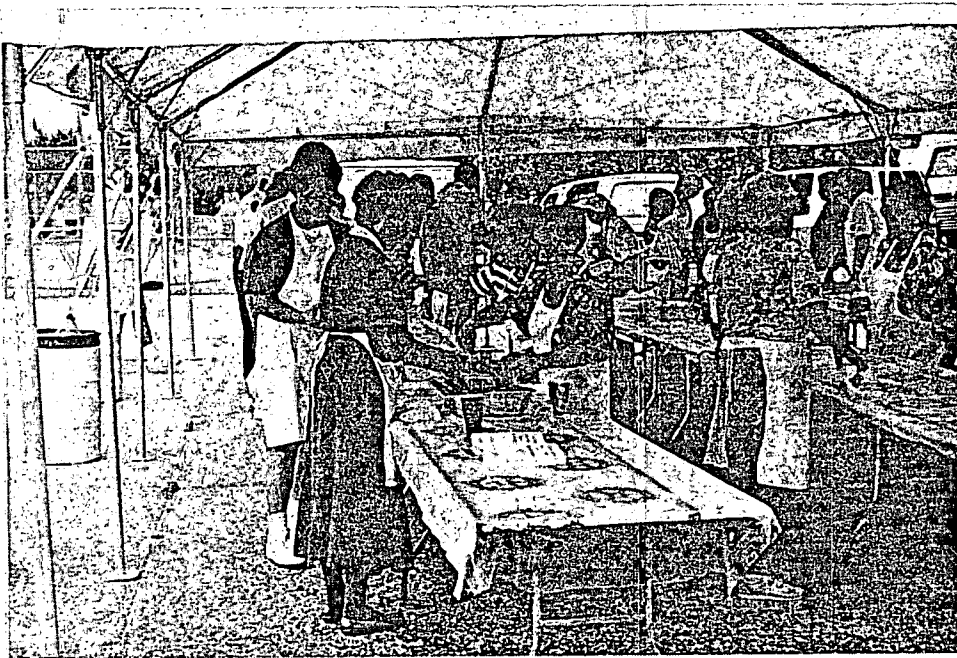

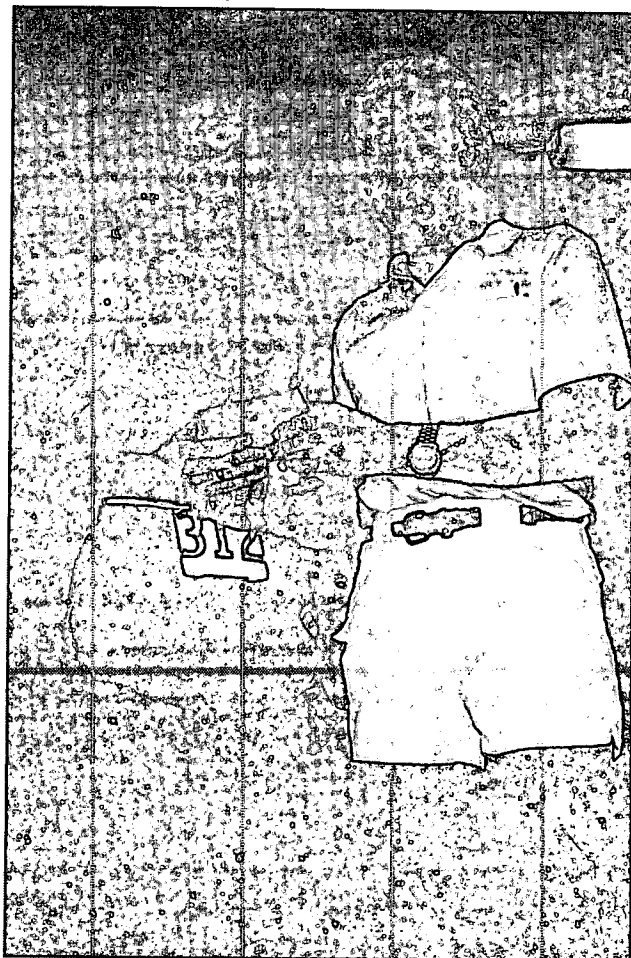
Senior volunteers came through for us again this year and handled the serving of hundreds of plates of shrimp, fish and hot dogs for the kids.



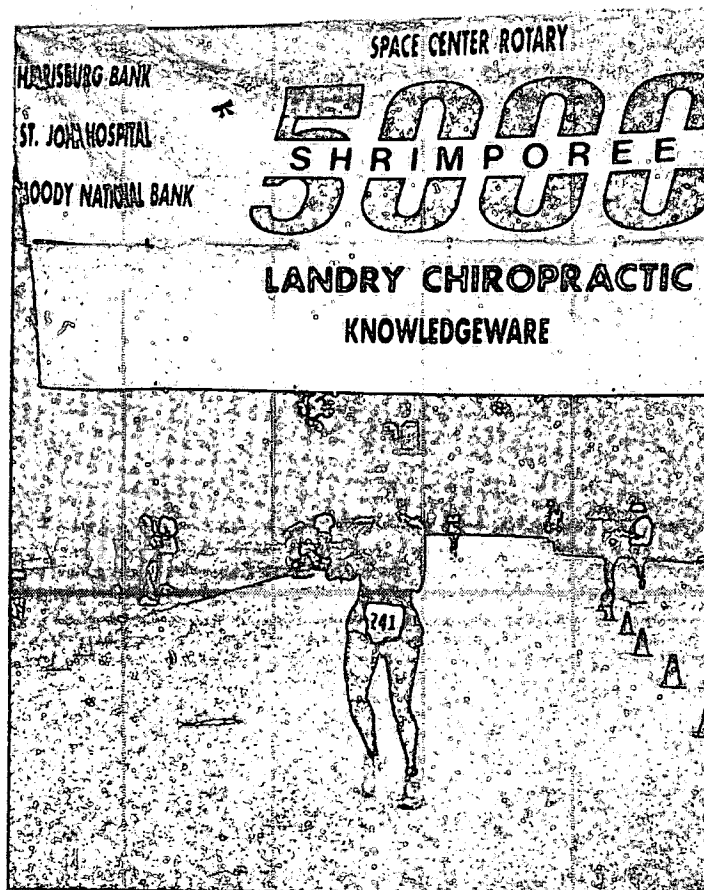
Sandy Saucely and the "Accounts Receivable" crew worked hard to collect the Auction money that funds our youth and community service projects.
