

NEW PILOT PROGRAM

The Rotary Int'l. Foundation is funding a new pilot program called Vocational Study Scholarships. It consists of grants of \$10,000 to \$15,000 for individuals to pursue further training in their vocation. An individual must have at least two years experience in their field to qualify, and the recipients will be favored if they emphasize environmental protection, drug abuse prevention, literacy, the aging or hunger prevention. Low income countries' applicants will also be given special consideration.

Another aspect of this program is to create a resource listing of those institutions in a given district which might want to serve as a training site for Vocational Study. It can be a university, academy, governmental agency, company or organization. If you wish to propose a Vocational Scholar, or propose a study site for the resource listing, contact Dr. David Taylor at 332-6513.
