# TODAY'S PROGRAM: CHARLES C. FOSTER

Charles C. Foster is President of Tinday & Foster, P.C., and head of the Immigration Law Section of the firm. He is also the honorary consul General of the Kingdom of Thailand. A native of Galveston, MR Foster received his Bachelors Degree from the University of Texas and his Tyris Doctorate from the University of Texas School of Law. Mr. Foster serves as a board member and is past national President of the American Immigration Lawyers Association, Chairman of the American Bar Assolication Coordinating Committee on Immigration law and Vice Chairman of the Houston Bar Foundation. During the 2000 Presidential Campaign, MR. Faster seaved as the principal advisor to President Bush on U.S. immigration policy. He is Chairman of the Asia Society-Texas Center, past President of the Houston Forum and Board member and past President of the Houston Club. He is a Director of the Greater Houston Partnership and past chairman of its Economic Development and World Tracle Divisions. He is also Director of the Mexican Institute of Greater Houston, the Greater Houston Preservation Atliance, Houston Holocaust Museum, Institute of International Education, Houston Ballet, Houston International Festival, Trustee of the Asia Society-New York, member of the Council on Foreign Relations in New York and to-Chairman, Texas 2020, ADL and past Direction and officer of the Houston World Affairs Council. He is a recipient of severas Royal decorations from His Majesty the King of Thailand and he received the 2000 Distinguished Friends of China Award and the 1991s International Service Award of the Houston Junior Chamber of Commerce and was the 1948 Honoree of the American Immigration Law Foundation for Excellence in the Practice of Immigration Law. MR Foster is markied to Lily Foster and they have two children.


