

Interfaith Caring Ministries provides services to over 3000 families, comprised of 7,500 individuals, in the Clear Creek and Dickinson Independent School Districts. One of their services is the Food Pantry. Generally, ICM provides enough food for each person in a needy household to last for five days. While any canned or non-perishable grocery item is appreciated, ICM has particular need for canned meats (tuna, spam, etc.), diapers (any size), toilet paper, mac and cheese, peanut butter and jelly, cereal, canned vegetables and fruits, shampoo, toothpaste, and feminine hygiene items. Store brands and off brands are just fine. Also very appreciated are gift cards to any area grocery store, which ICM uses to purchase items in high demand. Either add one or more of these items to your grocery list each week, or pull extras out of your own pantry that you happen to have on hand. Thanks, Rotarians! Jean Walker

In Memorian

Sadly we report the death of Jerry Hammack, a long time member of SCRC and president in 1968-69. Jerry passed away Monday evening at Harbor View in South Shore Harbor after a lengthy battle with cancer. A couple of years ago he was named an Honorary member of SCRC due to his medical condition and inability to maintain regular attendance. Jerry is well known among the NASA and International Space Community. A Georgia Tech graduate, he was part of the few that worked for the N.A.C.A. in Langley, which later became NASA and moved to Houston to start what was called the Manned Space Center, later named Johnson Space Center. He was also one of the few engineers who were co-owners of the space vehicle Mercury patent. He worked for NASA until his retirement in 1987, but continued the support of the space program as a contractor until just a few years ago. Our condolences to his wife and family. Jerry's smile and Rotary spirit will be missed.
