Rotary International has indicated a special interest in this new club due to its location and the type of membership which includes Gordon Cooper, one of the original astronauts. We're expecting "Gordo" to be there along with some of the other astronauts. We're also expecting a host of Rotarians from District 589 and their Anns to be there to participate in the presentation of the charter to this new Rotary Club.

Many things need to be done between now and Monday, September 28, when the charter will be presented at the Houston Yacht Club near La Porte. We need the support and cooperation of all Rotarians in the district.

Since accommodations are limited and since the new club has 35 members, this means only about 100 additional Rotarians and their Anns can be taken care of at the Charter Presentation.

All details have not been worked out and additional information will be sent to you as these matters are finalized. We will have an outstanding speaker and an outstanding program, and we know your Club will want to be represented. ALL Clubs in the district are requested to have representatives present.

Have your treasurer send in your contribution for "gifts" for the new club at once; also, ask your members to get their ticket requests in the mail without delay.
