SUBJECT: ORGANIZATION OF INTERACT CLUB OUTSIDE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF SPONSORING CLUB

STATEMENT: Article IV, Paragraph 1, of the standard Interact club constitution provided that "Each Interact club shall be sponsored by the Rotary club whose territorial limits embrace the area from which the Interact members are drawn unless written authority is granted by the board of directors of Rotary International to organize an Interact club outside the territorial limits of the sponsoring Rotary club."

Acting in behalf of the Rotary Club of Space Center (Houston), Texas, U.S.A., and at the request of the district governor of District 589, the district governor nomines of District 589, requested authorization for the sponsorship by the Rotary Club of Space Center (Houston) of an Interact club in Clear Creek High School located in District 591 six miles from the Rotary Club of Space Center (Houston).

The governor of District 591 indicated approval of the sponsorship of the proposed Interact club in District 591.

DECISION: The board, the general secretary acting in its behalf, authorizes the Rotary Club of Space Center (Houston), Texas, U.S.A., to organize an Interact club in Clear Creek High School located outside, but in territory adjacent to, the territorial limits of the Rotary Club of Space Center (Houston), Texas, U.S.A.

REQUEST FOR AUTHORITY TO SPONSOR AN INTERACT CLUB OUTSIDE THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF THE SPONSORING ROTARY CLUB

The board of directors of R. I. at its May, 1965 meeting, approved an amendment to Article IV, section 1 of the standard Interact club constitution, to provide that "Each Interact club shall be sponsored by the Rotary club whose territorial limits embrace the area from which the Interact members are drawn, unless written authority is granted by the board of directors of Rotary International to organize an Interact club outside the territorial limits of the sponsoring Rotary club..." Pursuant to this provision, Clyde L. Coleman, governor-nominee of District 589 (Texas, U.S.A.), acting in behalf of the Rotary Club of Space Center (Houston), Texas, U.S.A., at the request of District Governor Rufus B. Clouse, has requested that the Rotary Club of Space Center be allowed to sponsor an Interact club in the Clear Creek High School which is outside its territorial limits.

Governor-nominee Coleman has supplied the following information in connection with this request:

1. The Rotary Club of Space Center (Houston) is in district 589; the Clear Creek High School lies across the district boundary in District 591. Governor-nominee Coleman has sent the secretariat a copy of a letter to him from the governor of district 591 which reads in part:

You are advised that District 591 hereby approves the sponsorship of an Interact club, by the Space Center Rotary club, in the Clear Creek High School.

- 2. The Clear Creek High School is six miles from Space Center, but the school enrollment is primarily made up of students from Space Center.
- 3. Space Center is the nearest Rotary club to the Clear Creek High School. The next nearest are Dickinson in district 591 (12 miles away) and LaPorte in district 589 (15 miles away).

The Rotary Club of Space Center has requested Governor-nominee Coleman, as the Interact Liaison officer of District 589, to seek this authorization from the board in their behalf.

Does the board grant authority for the Rotary Club of Space Center (Houston), Texas, U.S.A. to sponsor an Interact club at the Clear Creek High School?
