Arrangements have been made with NASA Manned Spacecraft Center Public Affairs Office for Rotarian kids to tour MSC on June 13. Buildings normally open to the public will be visited and movies will be shown in the auditorium of the Visitors Center. Kids will be welcomed by MSC officials and/or astronauts, depending on availability at the time. Members of Space Center Rotary Club will assist in shepherding kids from building to building.

First bus will leave the Albert Thomas Convention Center at 9:00 a.m., and the first returning bus will depart the MSC area at 3:00 p.m., to arrive at the Convention Center at approximately 4:00 p.m. Other buses will leave sequentially.

Lunch will be available for the kids at the two MSC cafeterias. A fixed menu, e.g., fried checken, potatoes, vegetable, salad, rolls and butter, salad, dessert will be available for \$1.50. The price of the meal should be collected in advance to facilitate services at the cafeterias.

After lunch the students will be bussed to the nearby Clear Lake Park (Harris County property) which is about a mile from the Center and situated on the shores of Clear Lake. Arrangements will be made for entertainment in the form of a "Moon Rock Concert" with local young people providing the "music" (?).

Permission has been secured from Harris County officials to use the park on June 13 and, as a back-up, we have reserved Galveston County Park, which is about five miles from MSC. Busses will assemble at the Clear Lake Park and deport from there for return to Houston.
