The annual Clear Creek Basin Water Quality Study has had its fourth successful year, and the students' report on the condition of the basin will be ready for distribution within the month. Over these past four years, Earth Awareness, with the assistance of the community, has provided 73 student fellowships totaling \$24,900, and 6 teacher stipends totaling \$5,250. Three of these studies have earned for their participants the nation's highest award for environmental protection achievement, the Citation of Merit from the President of the United States.

We are now initiating plans for the fifth study which will commence the first of June. Applications will be made available to five local high schools, and student directors from last year's study will be working through the spring holidays preparing orders for chemicals and supplies.

In order to facilitate the obtaining of necessary supplies, EAF would appreciate receiving contributions to the '75 summer study as soon as possible. This letter asks that Rotary Club of Space Center approve the contribution of \$300 to EAF to assist in the early planning of the 1975 Clear Creek Basin Water Quality Study.
