#### Meeting Minutes

The International Youth Committee met on June 20. Members attending were Karen Birchenough, Joe Hang (Director), Bill Geissler, Bob Zehentner, Max Yarbrough, Dixie Robison, Doug Schuler, Bailey Chaney, Haley Winters, Dan Bochsler, and Alan Wylie. With the large attendance and enthusiasm of the members, the numerous tasks for the committee were defined and the appropriate responsibilities were assigned to committee members. It was decided to meet regularly once a month, the next meeting to be July 18 at Alan Wylie's residence. Time \_ 7 PM.

The budget given to the board was discussed. The main budget item is the expense for the long term exchange student. One continuing question has been when to fund Rotary trips for the exchange student. Karen proposed that the parents for future exchange students be contacted early about the IY summer tour to determine if they have the funds for this trip. If so, Rotary money can be used for other trips such as District Conference and the Mexico trip.

An overview of the yearly activities was discussed. See enclosure which has been updated since the meeting. Items coming up in the next month or two include the short term summer program and hosting the Dallas visitors in July.

At Dixie Robison's suggestion, the responsibilities for the committee were subdivided into long term exchange, short term exchange, hosting International Youth visits, coordination of NASA tours, scholarships, and promotion of Interact involvement with the committee. The chairman and members for each of these subcommittees are enclosed. Key discussion items for these various areas follow.

# Hosting Long Term Exchange Student Here through Dee.

Patty Becerra, our current IY student from Peru, is now with the Schulers -- her third host family. Everyone coming in contact with Patty has been most impressed with this young lady. Yet the number of people who have come to know Patty is small. Doug pointed out that Patty often gets lonely since his family members work during the week days. How to rectify this situation promoted much discussion.

Dixie Robison agreed to be the social director for Patty. Basically, this involves getting both the Rotary members and Interact members more involved in activities with Patty. Dixie proposed step 1 during the meeting -- getting Patty to participate with the YMCA summer program. Steve Bolton was contacted by telephone and agreed. Dixie and Doug will follow up with Patty. At a coming club social (July 8) involving Rotary Club officers, directors, and committee chairman, Joe Hang pointed out that Patty should be invited. The Wylies volunteered to take Patty to the party.

Karen Birchenough is the counselor for Patty. This has worked out extremely well. Max Yarbrough volunteered to be the club point of contact with host families. Max is already working on a date to recognize the host families for Patty at an upcoming Rotary meeting.

## Short Term Program

An increased responsibility in this area can be assumed by providing more personal contact with outgoing students -- a follow-up and addition to the District orientation program. Activities for outgoing students would include orientation before their trip, a send-off at a club meeting (with club banners provided), and organizing a program when the students return. When the American students are hosting their foreign visitors, this committee would work to help organize activities and socials at the club level. Since this program is now in progress, this subcommittee has a short fuse on some important activities.

### Hosting International Youth Visits

Each year in the spring the Space Center Rotary Club hosts International Youth from the East Texas Rotary District 583 and the Houston district 589. Now, in addition, Dallas Rotarians are bringing down 11 short term French students with their Texas counterparts for a tour of NASA and Galveston. The visitors arrive on the evening of July 26 (Thursday) and leave the following Saturday in the a.m. Eleven host families are needed to host the 22 students. Five of these families were obtained from committee members at the meeting. Karen plans to contact the Stremels. An announcement will be made at the Rotary Club to get the other families.

The tour of NASA will be straight forward; the Galveston trip is to be defined. Karen and Dixie suggested that the Galveston trip consist of a trip to the Strand, with a trolley car ride to the beach. This suggestion sounds ideal and will be worked. A Friday evening pool party was proposed, with Bill Geissler volunteering. Sounds like another fun time.

### Interact Involvement

Alan Wylie will work with Kyle Sprecher and the Interact Club President to promote the Interact members' involvement in all of the committee activities. Dixie Robison and her social committee will work with the Interact club to promote their involvement with our exchange students.

## NASA Tours

Dan Bochsler is setting up the NASA tours for the short term students this summer. He will be getting in contact with Tony Sortino and David Taylor to learn the dates, and then getting in touch with Jack Lister to seek his support.

## Scholarships

Bill Geissler with his subcommittee will set up and promote the scholarship opportunities for both the short term and long term programs. This subcommittee will work closely with the high schools and perhaps should be regarded as our primary point of contact for the school. The sponsor for future exchange students, since he or she will

change for each student, could draw upon the scholarship committee for support. The scholarship committee could have the necessary clout with the school (since we are providing scholarships) and could serve as a reminder to the high schools that we deserve preferential treatment regarding foreign exchange students hosted by our club.
