The Space Center Rotary Club has developed a special program to honor excellent performance by individuals involved with the preparation, motivation, and guidance of our area children. The program is designed to select one outstanding professional for the year in the field of education. All Clear Creek School District full-time teachers are eligible for consideration. Nomination forms may be completed by anyone familiar with the educator's work experience.

The educator chosen will receive a Rotary International Excellence in Education Award of \$1000 cash, a personal plaque, another plaque for display at the educator's school, and the selectee's name will be placed on a perpetual plaque on display at the Board of Trustees building, as well as publicity, an honorary Rotary membership, and more.

The Rotary International Education Hall of Fame will be established with the first teacher chosen for this honor. It is Rotary International's plan that the Hall of Fame will grow each year as Rotary continues to honor the dedication of those who serve our communities' youth and our future.

Selected nominees will be contacted by Rotary to complete formal documentation of their educational careers. The 10 outstanding nominees will be interviewed by a Rotary Committee which will make the final selection of the Outstanding Teacher for 1991 for the Clear Creek I.S.D.

The award will be bestowed at a regular meeting of the Space Center Rotary Club. The school plaque will be presented at a school assembly to honor the teacher.

Space Center Rotary believes the teaching profession should be honored and recognized for its contribution to our community and believes this award for excellence in education will demonstrate its appreciation and value for our educators.
