The Space Center Rotary has been an invaluable partner of Clear Creek Independent School District (CCISD) for many years. This organization and its members, without question, share in our mission to make sure all children graduate college and workforce ready! We are well on our way in this effort with CCISD earning the Exemplary rating by the Texas Education Agency and more than 93% of all students passed the 2010 state assessment. Our students outperform their state and national peers on the SAT by 30 to 45 points in all areas. CCISD is home to an impressive number of National Merit Semifinalists and more than 1,200 of our high school students are currently enrolled in dual credit courses where they are simultaneously earning high school and college credit at the same time.
