Yesterday I had a meeting with the stove factory owner to see how best to use the funds. \$2000 will convert in 78 stoves on a basis of subsidizing 60% of the stove cost. It would be great to get the communities involved, where our actual water source is. This will help to reduce deforesting and will help to protect this water source, and give the side benefits to the people in these communities. They are situated about a 30 minute drive from Copan over an all weather dirt road. We can start producing the stove as soon as we have the funds and could deliver around the middle or end of February. This will give you some time to pack the suitcases!!
