


It also provides support to our DARTs (Disaster Aid Response Teams) as they now have the ability to communicate with the home office.

Our Family Survival Pack provides a survivor family with the basic tools to rebuild their lives. All products contained in our box meet and exceed UN and SPHERE standards and have innovative

For ease of transport and manoeuvrability, the box has wheels and a handle. Its capacity is 190 litres, with the lid serving as a carpenter's workbench with two 2"x4" saw grooves, and is completed with a tool holder.

Inside the box is a range of support items, most importantly, the Disaster Aid tent is the largest humanitarian aid tent available. And best of all, it is inter-connectable. Simply, we can erect a four classroom school for up to eighty school children; a hospital or erect a community centre - the deliverables are many and varied dependant on the need of those we serve.

Filled with blankets, water containers, cooking utensils, a stove, pots, pans, children rucksacks (with books and pencils), mosquito nets and other useful items.

We also include pure soap, which according to the WHO helps to alleviate the spreading of disease by up to 70%. Our box of 'hope' helps to rebuild broken lives - with dignity.
