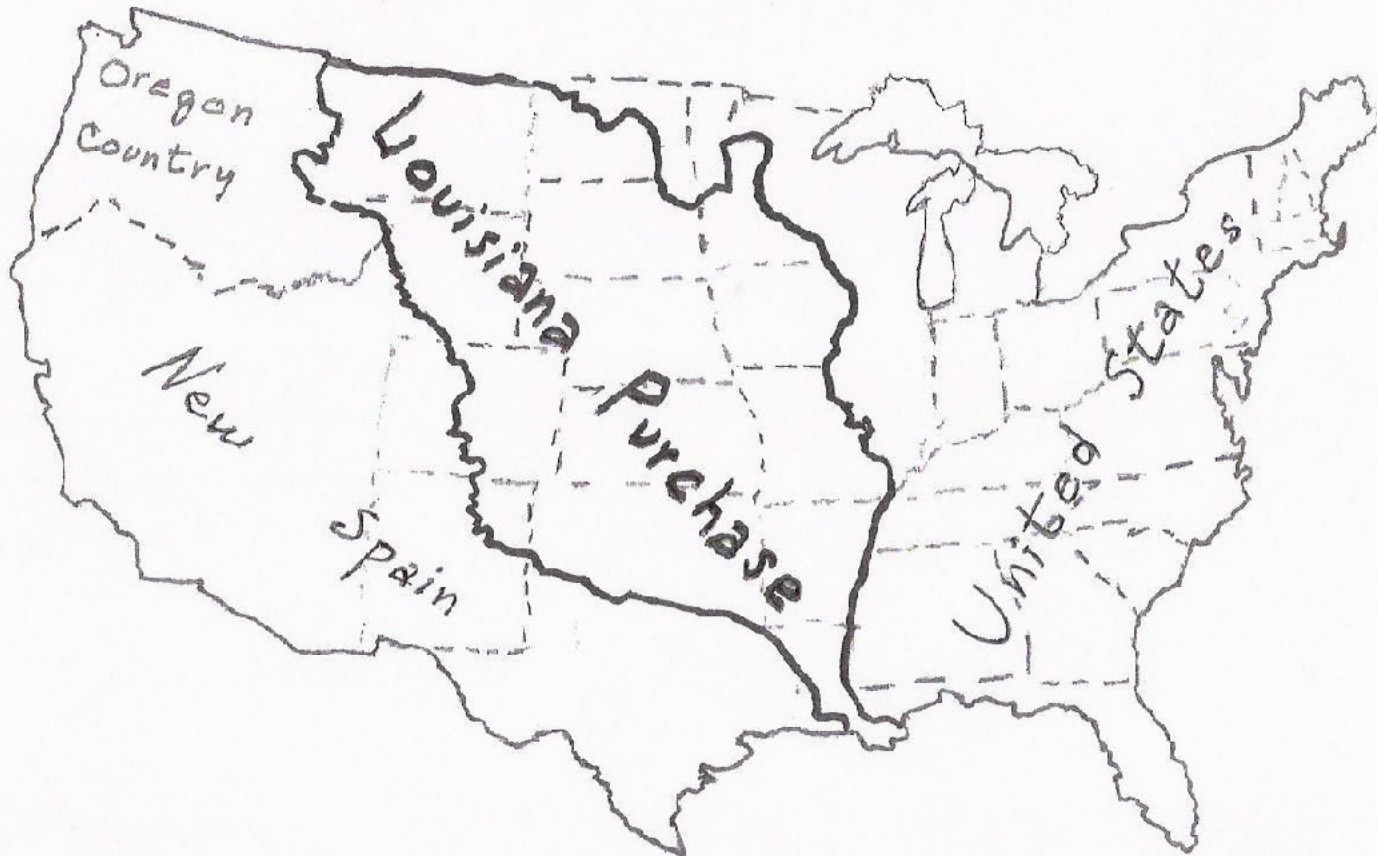
Map of the State of Missouri



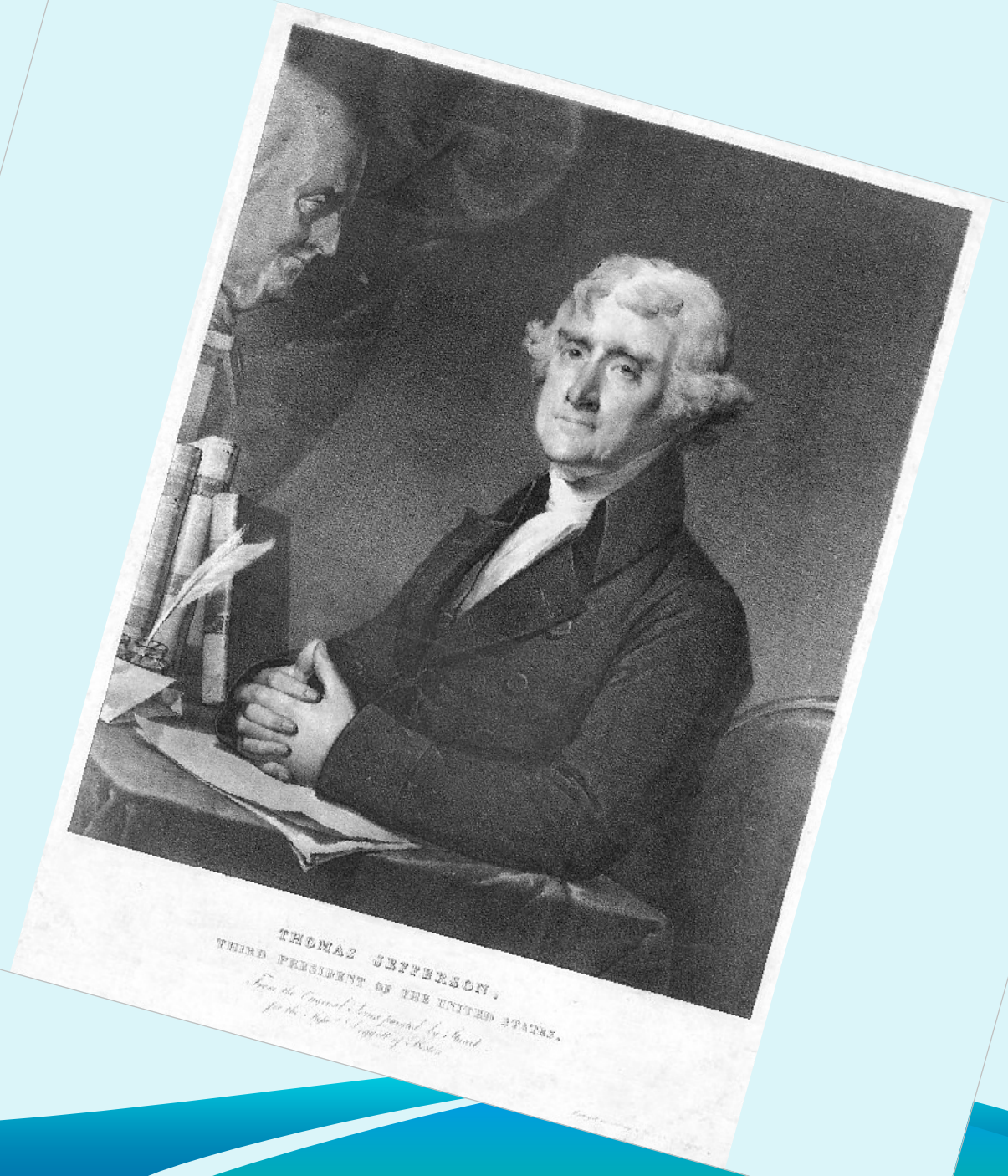

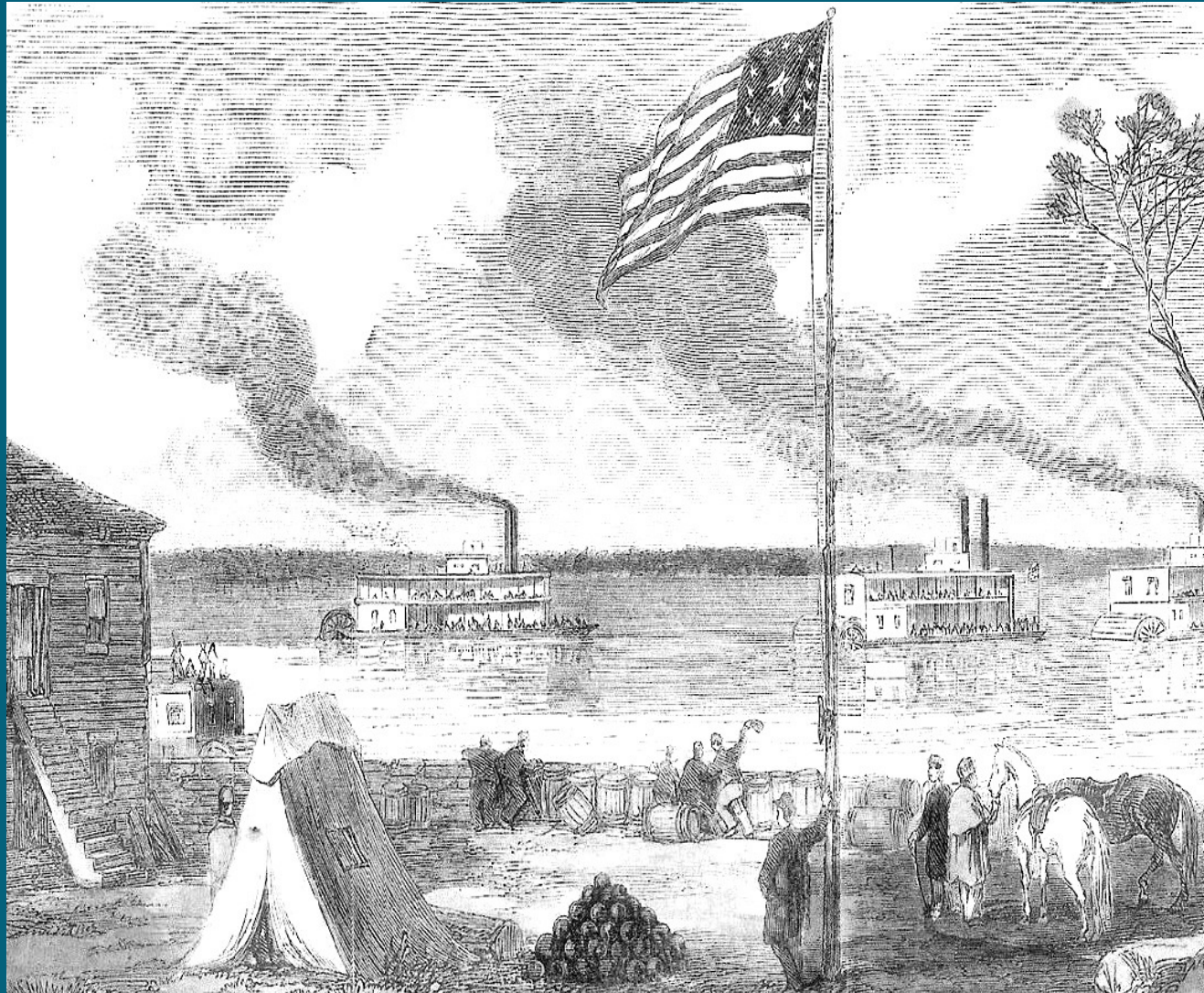

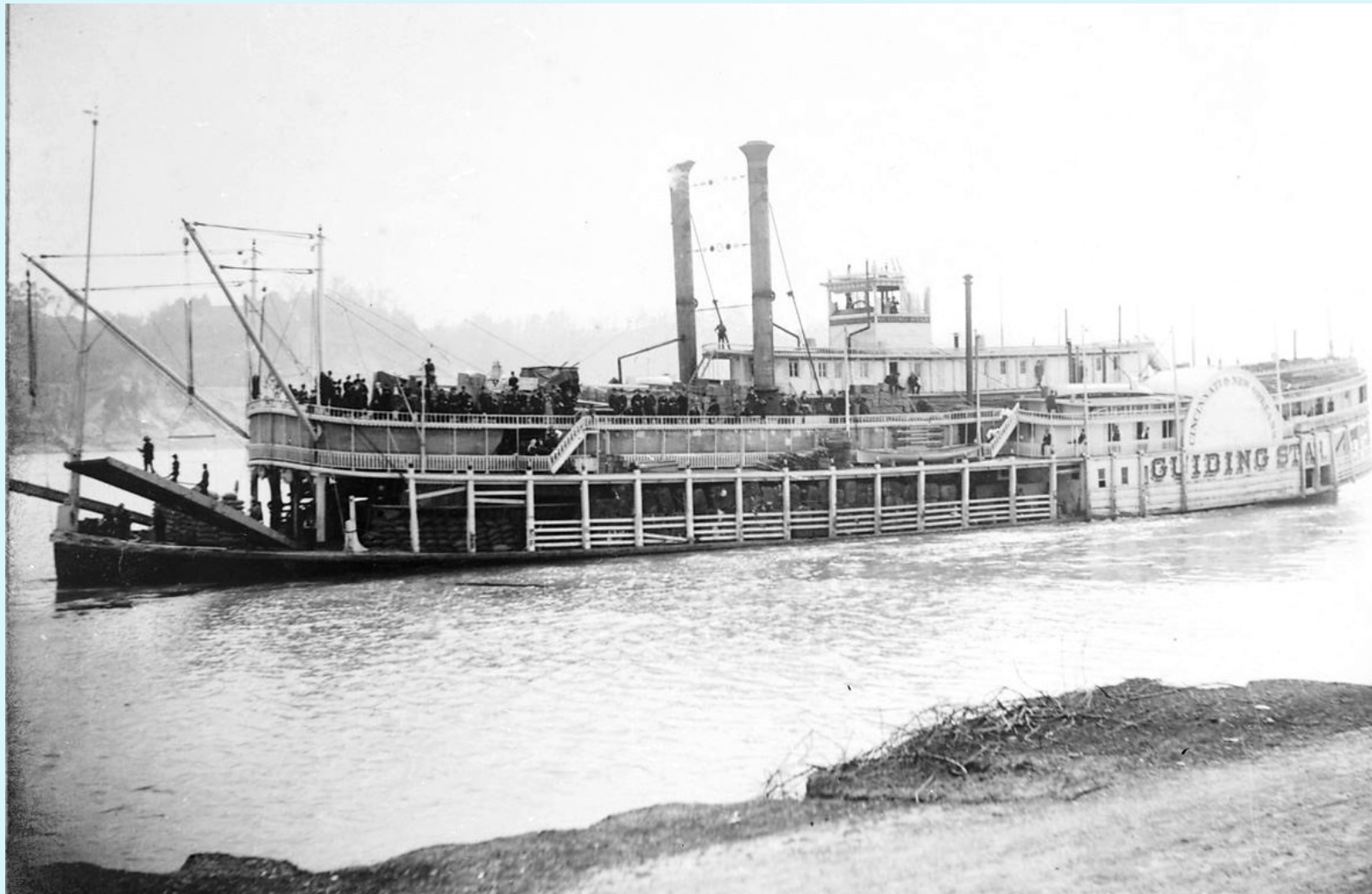

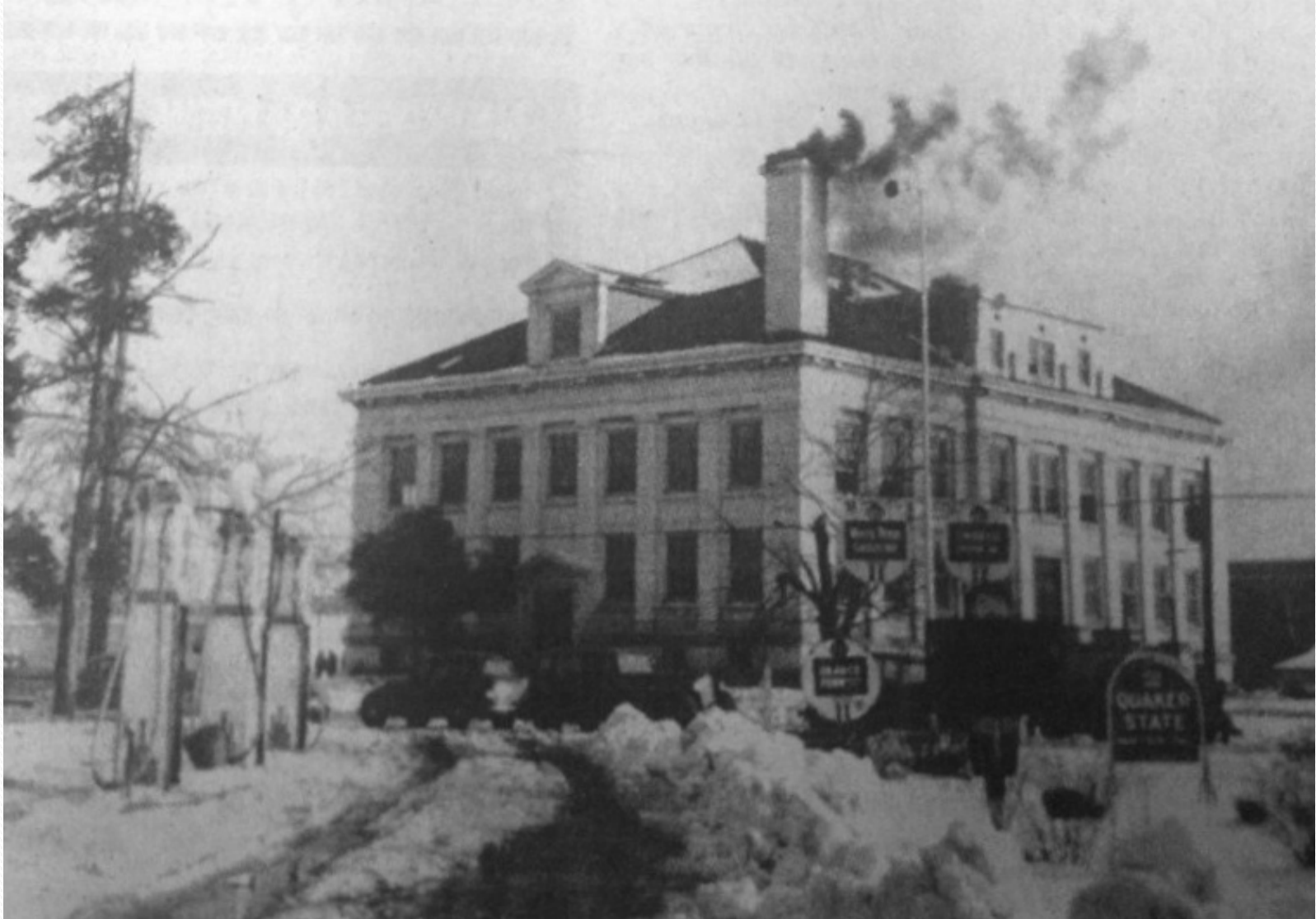


Mississippi River Steamboat - 1893



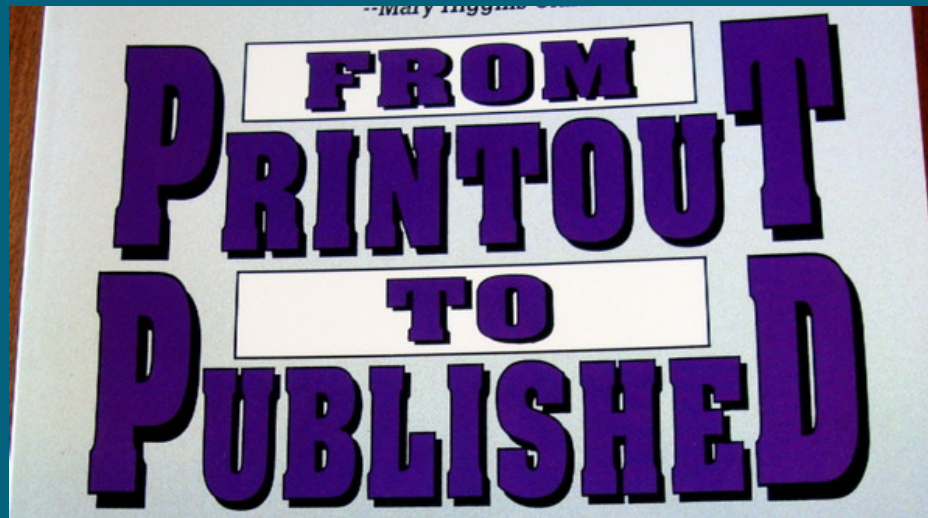
Mississippi River Flood – 1927



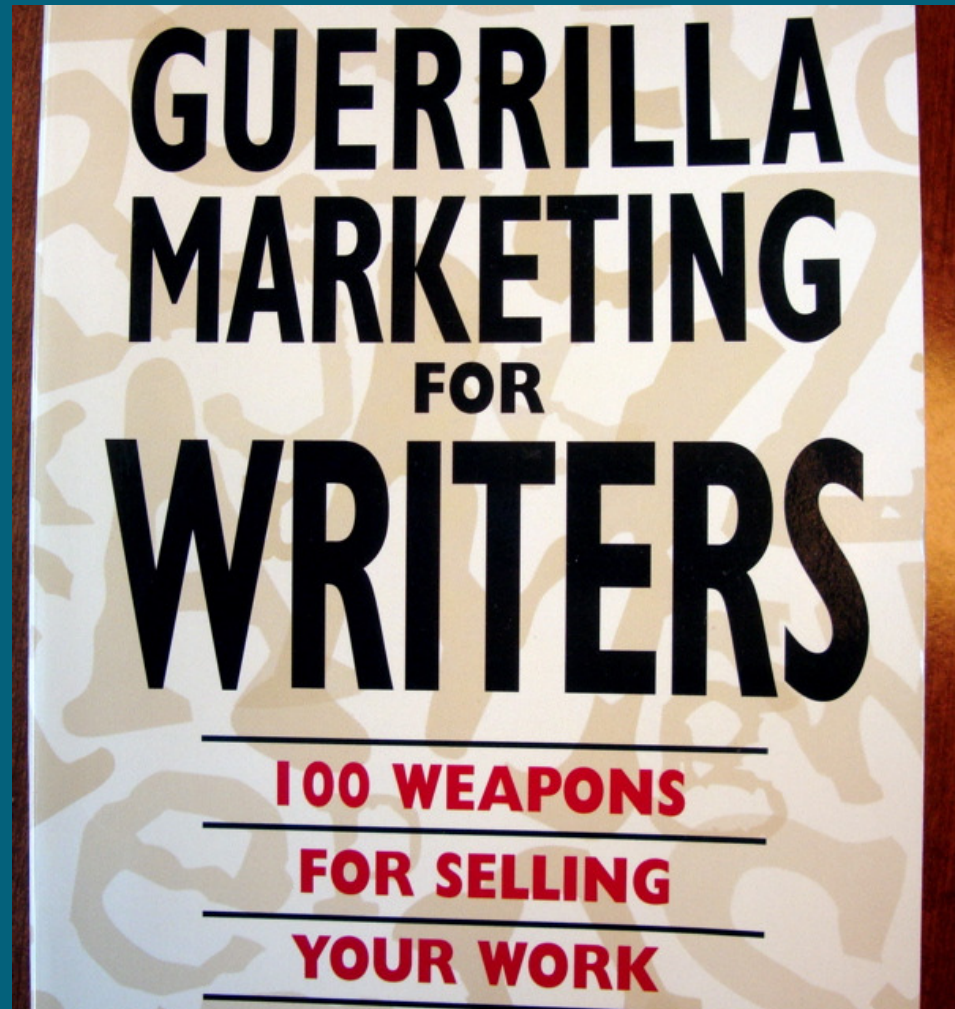

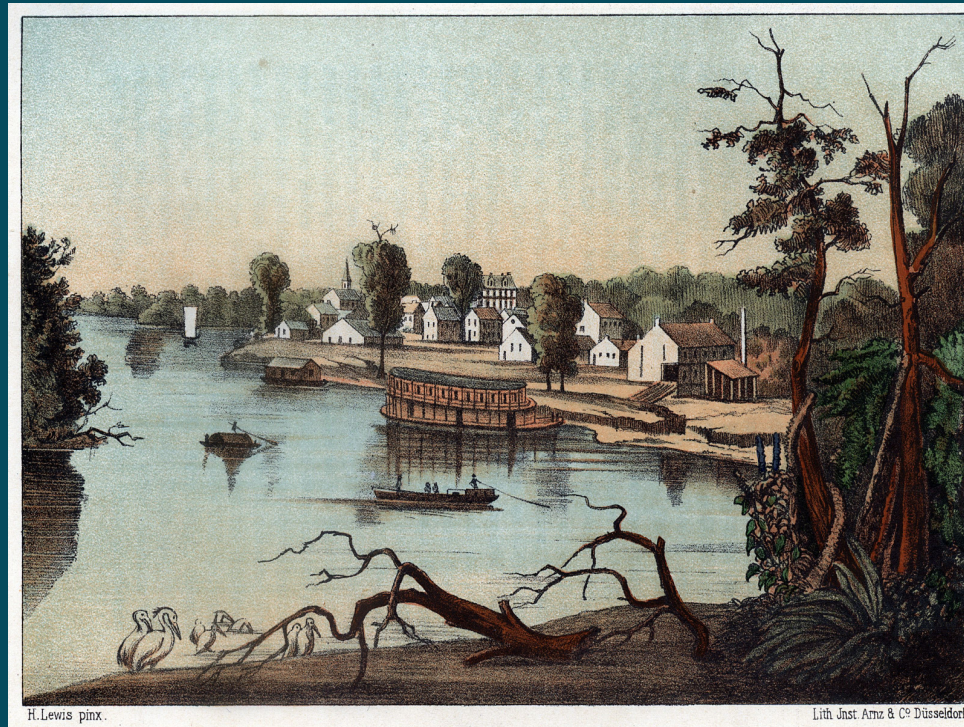
