Ralph Schimmel reported that of our new member goal for 85-86 of 44 that 44 have been proposed and 32 have been approved and inducted.

Under new business, the board passed a motion by Gene Lindquist to send \$500 to Goodwill Industries in the wake of the recent fire which destroyed their building.
